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## **ENRICHMENT PROGRAM: LEVEL 1 & 2**

By the time students are 7, they are ready to "Begin and Build" foundations in proper dance technique in addition to the fun of music and movement! #### TWIRL RED CARPET RECITAL

We celebrate our youngest dancers in a very special experience at the studio the last week of classes. They will walk down the red carpet, take photos, and dance for their favorite people- it is a memory families love to celebrate TOGETHER with their dancer! One fee covers costume, participation, and tickets!

#### STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

We are committed to providing leadership training for our students beyond the dance classroom. To that end, students may apply in August for the following opportunities:

**Age 13+** - Teacher Assistants work with teachers in the classroom a minimum of 1 class per week and receive studio credits in addition to leadership training twice per year.

**Age 16+** - Interns are able to sub for classes, lead Birthday Parties, teach at community outreaches, receive leadership training either in person or digitally.

### **PAYMENT**

- •Tuition fees are paid monthly or annually. Save 10% by paying for the full season by September 10th.
- The dance season starts September 5 and goes through May 23.
- All accounts must be set up on autopay with their credit or debit card. If you need an exception for this and desire to pay with cash or check, you must fill out an exception form at the front desk.
- Tuition installments are due on the 1st of each month. If tuition is not received by the 10th, a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed. Autopay accounts will be drafted between the 1st and the 5th of the month. Tuition will not be adjusted or discounted based on the length of the month, absenteeism, school closures, vacations, holidays, inclement weather, or the need to switch to virtual instruction due to government regulations. Dancers are encouraged to make up classes for missed classes during the current session.

## **TURNING POINTE ATTIRE**

- 1. Leotards may be camisole, tank, short or long sleeved
- 2. All levels may wear skirts of any color/pattern.
- 3. Hair must be pulled back in a braid, ponytail, or bun for all classes. Hair must be in a bun for Ballet levels 3-5 and Training students.
- 4. Students may wear tanks over their leotard, but it must be the same color as their leotard.
- 5. Bras may not be showing. Midriffs may not be showing. Crop tops must be worn with a leotard underneath
- 6. No booty/short shorts. Black athletic shorts may be worn only if tights or biker shorts are worn underneath.
- 7. Ladies ages 9 and up: cover ups for top and bottom must be worn over leotards when entering and leaving the premises (to promote modesty)

## **Dress Code Guidelines**

Twirl: light pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes (also black tap shoes for combo, optional skirt or tutu any color

Note: Twirl Showtime-boys need black jazz shoes, girls need tan jazz shoes- no tap shoes

Primary Ballet and Ballet/Tap, Ballet 1 and 1b: lavender or dark purple colored leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, optional skirt

Ballet 2 and 2b, PreTeen: light blue or royal blue leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, optional skirt

Ballet 3a and 3b: scarlet or burgundy leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, optional skirt or black shorts

Ballet 4 and 5, Teen Ballet: black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, skirt or black shorts

Adult Ballet: solid color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, skirt (any color/pattern) or black shorts

Training Division: black or navy leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, pointe shoes if applicable, optional skirt

Pre-Pointe: solid color leotard and pink tights

Pre-Pointe students also need to bring these items to class: yoga mat, beach/bath towel, foam roller, and tennis ball

Worship, Contemporary, Modern, and Acro: solid colored leotard or fitted shirt, black leggings, joggers, or shorts, and bare feet

Hip Hop: solid color tank or tee, black joggers, leggings, or shorts, hip hop sneakers or regular sneakers

Jazz: solid color tank or fitted tee, black leggings, joggers, or shorts, tan or skin toned slip on jazz shoes

Musical Theater and Primary MT: solid color tank or fitted tee, black leggings, joggers, or shorts

Levels Primary-4- tan/skin toned jazz shoes (girls) and black jazz shoes (boys)

Level 4b/5- black jazz shoes and tan character heels (ladies)

Leaps and Turns: solid color tank or tee, black leggings, joggers, or shorts, tan or black jazz shoes

**Irish:** solid color leotard or shirt, black leggings. Ankles must be visible. Black ballet shoes or black ghillies. Black tap shoes for hard shoe (needed for ages 9 and up, not for Irish 1 class). Traditional Irish hard shoes encouraged for Irish 4 and 5, optional for Irish 3.

Ballroom/Swing: comfortable clothes and shoes with rubber or suede sole. Heels for females are preferred but not necessary (no heels for swing)

Tap: Black joggers/leggings need to show knee alignment or be able to be pulled up over the knee. Solid color top

Black lace up hard shank tap shoes (no split sole or slip ons)

Creative Collaborators: comfortable clothes you can move in/workout clothes

Men: black athletic pants or shorts (fitted not tight), white or black shirt, black ballet shoes

**Acting/Voice**: comfortable clothes

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
