

Who Needs a Ticket:

Reminder that each dancer gets 2 free tickets included with the recital fee (not per show, per dancer since recital fee is paid per dancer not per show)...this is what the ticket code is for. Stage moms do not need a ticket for the show they are working at. Your dancer does not need a ticket if they are dancing in the show because they will be backstage and do not need a seat. Dance with Cinderella dads DO need a ticket because they will not be backstage the whole show and will get to watch most of it. Children ages 2 and under do not need a ticket if they are in a lap.

Pick up Your Free Ticket Code:

The recital ticket codes are ready for pick up at the studio! I've attached a picture of the box. Each family should have a card with student names on the front and ticket code on the back to unlock your free tickets. If your dancer has a different last name with you, we put cards under the dancer's last name. but double check your last name too just in case. The cards are in alphabetical order by last names (there are dividers). If your card is not in there and you have a green statement, please make sure your recital fee is paid and then we will get your card in the box within a few days. If you've looked through and can't find your card, please fill out the sheet on the front desk and we will get one made for you.

Purchasing Through TutuTix:

We're working with a company called TutuTix to make it easier for you to purchase recital tickets, flowers, and DVD's. Gone are the days of coming to the studio, waiting in line, filling out paperwork and spending your valuable time purchasing tickets. NOW, you'll be able to do it from the convenience of your own living room, office, or wherever you are.

At that time, you can purchase tickets by any of the following ways:

Ticket prices will be: **\$6.25 or \$7.35**

Note that you will need a credit or debit card to buy tickets, and that tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis. So, buy early to get better seats! TutuTix charges a low, fair fee for their service. You'll see their \$1 per ticket fee, plus 5% processing charge added to your order at checkout.

Enter Free Ticket Code BEFORE Selecting Seats:

For the promo code, when you are on the home page, you click on "buy tickets" for whichever recital, then scroll down and it says "promo code"...this is where **you enter your code first (don't select seats first)**. Then you select tickets and you should be able to choose the amount of free tickets.

What if Code Doesn't Work or I Purchased Too Many?

If your code did not take off the 2 free tickets per student or you missed the place to put it in,

please call Tututix the same day of purchase to get a refund for those. Or if you need to exchange or purchased too many, **please call Tututix and they will help you!! 855-222-2TIX (2849)**. Their customer service is SO helpful!

Only Choose the Amount of Free Tickets your Code is For:

If you choose all of your tickets as free, it will take you all the way until you submit your order and then it will tell you that your code does not support that many free items and you'll have to go back through and re-select your seats (**reminder it's 2 free tickets per dancer**).

Special note for ADA:

If you have someone in a wheelchair, there is no specified ADA seating at Wasson. The district policy is to put wheelchairs in the front of the auditorium beside the first few rows. We have reserved some ADA companion seats on the end of the first few rows for those needing to sit by someone a wheelchair. So please only reserve those seats if you are an ADA companion and they should be marked on the seating chart.
